Faith or Works?

Sometimes we think the argument of faith vs. works started with the Reformation. But the second reading shows that it was already being debated in New Testament times. The simplified version of the debate has the Reformers saying that faith alone is all we need to be saved, while the Catholic side says we have to do good to be saved. Actually, they are both right.

Jesus came to show that only God is Holy. Our holiness comes from loving God and loving others. Because Jesus is the Son of God, he is the best way to know God. So believing in Jesus is not just believing that he exists. We believe in a Person who loves us and showed us that God is our Father. He gives us life and protects us; He supports us and also lets us learn from our mistakes. Then He forgives us, showing that he loves us even when we turn away from him.

So if we truly believe in Jesus, we follow his commandment of love. Because we love Him so much we want to be just like Him. We help others, not to make us look good, but to show them how good God is. So you cannot truly believe in Jesus without wanting to help others to know and love Him too. Jesus' way of saying that in today's gospel was to take up our cross and follow him. That is truly a work of faith.

Children's Liturgy of the Word: Is currently unavailable at the 9:00 am Mass as we assess space and volunteer needs in hopes of re-starting this ministry sometime in the Fall of 2021.

Religious Education Programs: Nativity School serves students in grades K4 through 8. The Parish School of Religion (PSR) is offered for other parish children, grades K4 through 8, enrolled in non-parochial schools. Registration for the 21-22 school year is underway and classes start on Sep. 12. For more information, please contact Mary Smith at 843-795-3821

Creating Safe Environments: All volunteers who minister in programs involving children at Nativity Parish or School are required to complete the Safe-Haven Online Abuse Prevention Training program. 

The Diocese of Charleston and the association of South Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities (SCICU), has filed a federal lawsuit against the state to remove the Blaine Amendment from the state constitution. The removal of this amendment will provide appropriate emergency relief funding for private and religious schools across South Carolina.

The Blaine Amendment unconstitutionally denies students equal access and opportunities to thrive; it fundamentally denies private schools the financial support to succeed based on bigotry. This FAQ Sheet (below) provides key information about the federal lawsuit. We encourage you to learn more about this important suit, and how abolishing this amendment helps all students in our state.

This an important time in history, as the Church is the first institution to ever sue a state over the Blaine Amendment. We ask for your continued support and prayers for the remainder of the legal proceedings.

The **BLAINE** Amendment



HISTORY

The Blaine Amendment was added to the S.C. state constitution when Gov. Benjamin Tillman and others in power, post-Reconstruction Era, adopted the Constitution of 1895. It prohibited state funds to Catholic institutions, schools and universities that were founded to serve people freed by the Emancipation Proclamation.



WHERE & WHAT

South Carolina's current Blaine Amendment is found in Section 4 of the state constitution's article on education. It prohibits taxpayer aid to independent and religious schools. The S.C. Supreme Court has interpreted this provision to also prohibit publicly-funded student scholarships paid to schools.



LEGALIZED BIGOTRY

Blaine Amendments were first drafted in the late 1800s as part of a wave of anti-Catholic bigotry. Politicians nationwide worked to block public funds from going to Catholic schools and ministries as America experienced a surge of Catholic immigrants. Catholic schools also educated a majority of Black students in South Carolina at that time, making the amendment discriminatory against Black education.



TODAY

The Blaine Amendment continues to retain a ban on direct aid to independent and religious schools, which continues racial and anti-Catholic sentiment. It blocks Catholic and independent schools from receiving proper government neutral grant funds established by the CARES Act and Governor Emergency Education Relief (GEER) funding.



LAWSUIT

The Diocese of Charleston and the association of South Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities, including five historically black colleges, have filed a federal lawsuit to remove the Blaine Amendment from the state constitution and to provide equal access to emergency relief funds.



NATIONWIDE

Thirty-five American states have Blaine Amendments written into their constitutions. Though the U.S. Supreme Court has struck a number of them down for other reasons, this lawsuit strikes right at the root of amicus which motivated the Blaine Amendments.


