

Why does this matter?

Christ's Resurrection from the dead changes everything! It is the be-all and the end-all of the Christian faith. As Paul himself put it: "If Jesus is not raised from the dead, our preaching is in vain and we are the most pitiable of men."

It's no good, of course, trying to explain the resurrection away or rationalize it as a myth, a symbol, or an inner subjective experience. None of that does justice to the novelty and sheer strangeness of the Biblical message. The Resurrection isn't just a subjective event or symbol.

It comes down finally to this: if Jesus was not raised from death, Christianity is a fraud and a joke; if He did rise from death, then Christianity is the fullness of God's revelation, and Jesus must be the absolute center of our lives. There is no third option.

So on Easter Sunday, let us not domesticate the stunning and disturbing message of the Resurrection. Rather, let us allow it to unnerve us, change us, set us on fire.

Christ is Risen, Alleluía!

THINGS TO KNOW

Nursery: Is offered to children age 6 weeks to 4 yrs. old during the Sunday 9:00 am Mass. It is located on the right side of the school's breezeway entrance. **The Nursery is temporarily closed until site renovations are completed.**

Religious Education Programs: Nativity School serves students in grades K4 through 8. The Parish School of Religion (PSR) is offered for other parish children, grades K4 through 8, enrolled in non-parochial schools. For more information. please contact Mary Smith at 843-795-3821 x 104.

Creating Safe Environments: All volunteers who minister in programs involving children at Nativity Parish or School are required to complete the Safe-Haven Online Abuse Prevention Training program. Baptism: To schedule a Baptism preparation class, a parent should be an active parishioner. For more information please contact Mary Smith at 843-795-3821 x 104.

Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation: A two year preparation period is required for these sacraments. Children planning to receive First Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the 2nd grade, must also have participated in a 1st grade PSR or Catholic school program. Children planning to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the 8th grade must also have participated in a 7th grade PSR or Catholic school program. In addition **FORMED** is **FREE** to all members of Nativity. The parish has a subscription that allows every one of us to access/use this 'library' at zero personal expense. To take advantage of this opportunity, you need only to go through a few simple steps to sign up.

Visit https://formed.org, click "Sign Up" and select "I belong to a Parish". Find "Church of the Nativity" on the list, type in your email address and you are in. You will receive a link in your e-mail. A Smart phone app is also available.
