

Who is Jesus for you?

In fact, the question of Jesus' identity and authority is one of the most important themes of Mark's entire Gospel. Various people in Mark's Gospel have tried to answer that question but their answers always fall short of capturing Jesus' full identity. For some Jesus is a wonder worker and for others a teacher. Still others see him as a prophet. In this passage we read about Peter identifying Jesus as the Messiah and our Lord using the term "Son of Man" to speak of Himself.

So how are we to respond as His disciples? Who we believe Jesus is will determine how far we will go in following Him and what sacrifices we will be willing to make for the sake of discipleship. Jesus can make a radical claim on our lives only because He is the Son of God. When we reduce the Lord to anything less than God incarnate, we also diminish our necessary response as His disciples.

If we are following someone we truly believe to be the Lord, we need to understand and accept the implications of that belief. Namely, as Lord, Jesus has total claim to every part of our lives. He is Lord of our homes and our families; of our marriages and of our businesses. He is Lord of our finances, sexuality, and politics. He is Lord of our leisure, our habits, and our friendships. Jesus asks each of us to answer this question as a fundamental act of our discipleship and subsequently to live out the consequences of that response.

THINGS TO KNOW

Nursery

For children ages 6 wks to 4 yrs. old during the Sunday 9 AM Mass. It is located on the right side of the school's breezeway entrance. *Temporarily closed due to site renovations.*

Religious Education Programs

Nativity School serves students in grades K4 through 8. The Parish School of Religion (PSR) is offered for other parish children (K4-Gr 8), enrolled in non-parochial schools. For information, please contact the Director of Religious Education.

Safe Environments Training for Volunteers

All volunteers who minister in programs involving children at Nativity Parish or School are required to complete prevention education and a background check. To initiate the process and volunteer, please contact the Parish Office Administrator.

Baptism

To schedule a Baptism preparation class, a parent should be an active parishioner. Godparents for Baptism must be active parishioners of Nativity or another Catholic parish. For information, please contact the Director of Religious Education.

Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation

These sacraments require a 2-year preparation period. To receive First Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the 2nd grade, children must have participated in a 1st grade PSR or Catholic school program; to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the 8th grade children must have participated in a 7th grade PSR or Catholic school program. For information, please contact the Director of Religious Education.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples must contact the priest at least six months prior to the proposed marriage date. For inquiry, contact the Parish Office.

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

This pastoral ministry provides compassionate presence, prayer, and sacraments to parishioners confined to their home, hospital, or nursing home. It includes Extraordinary Ministers to the Sick and Eucharistic Ministers who bring Holy Communion. To arrange a pastoral visit, please contact the Parish Office.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

This sacrament is received by those suffering from a potentially life-threatening illness, those planning to have serious surgery, and those in advanced years. Please do not wait until the 'last minute' to request the sacrament; contact the Parish Office.

Alpha

"Alpha" is a time to connect in a small group with others who are open to exploring life, faith, and meaning. Weekly sessions include sharing a meal, a brief video on an element of the Christian faith, and an opportunity for sharing individual thoughts and questions. 


