

What really counts?

Jesus warns his disciples against the wrong kind of behavior. In his denunciation of the Scribes (the religious experts of his day), He warns against the desire for prominence, against the desire for recognition and against using one's position (even a religious position) for self-gain.

Jesus cautions against following the example of the Scribes. Their actions, such as wearing long robes and giving greetings in market places, were intended to draw public attention to themselves. The first seats in Synagogues and first couches at dinners were places of honor that demonstrated the social status of those who occupied them. These actions may sound harmless and may be perceived as mere trappings of privilege in an honor based society.

The phrase *devour widows' houses* means "cheating widows out of their property". In ancient times widows held little or no power in the courts. It was not uncommon for a husband to appoint, in his will, a Jewish legal expert, (e.g. a Scribe or Pharisee) to be the executor of his widow's estate. Essentially, this gave the executor opportunity and authority to exploit the widow's finances and assets for personal enrichment.

To this story of hypocrisy Jesus adds the touching example of the poor widow. She puts much less money in the box than the wealthy ones. However, she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood. Her offering is a sign of what devotion to God really means.

THINGS TO KNOW

Nursery

For children ages 6 wks to 4 yrs. old during the Sunday 9 AM Mass. It is located on the right side of the school's breezeway entrance. *Closed until number of volunteers are reached. Please Contact Mary Smith, DRE or Parish Office to volunteer.

Religious Education Programs

Nativity School serves students in grades K4 through 8. The Parish School of Religion (PSR) is offered for other parish children (K4-Gr 8), enrolled in non-parochial schools. For information, please contact the Director of Religious Education.

Safe Environments Training for Volunteers

All volunteers who minister in programs involving children at Nativity Parish or School are required to complete prevention education and a background check. To initiate the process and volunteer, please contact the Parish Office Administrator.

Baptism

To schedule a Baptism preparation class, a parent should be an active parishioner. Godparents for Baptism must be active parishioners of Nativity or another Catholic parish. For information, please contact the Director of Religious Education.

Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation

These sacraments require a 2-year preparation period. To receive First Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the 2nd grade, children must have participated in a 1st grade PSR or Catholic school program; to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the 8th grade children must have participated in a 7th grade PSR or Catholic school program. For information, please contact the Director of Religious Education.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples must contact the priest at least six months prior to the proposed marriage date. For inquiry, contact the Parish Office.

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

This pastoral ministry provides compassionate presence, prayer, and sacraments to parishioners confined to their home, hospital, or nursing home. It includes Extraordinary Ministers to the Sick and Eucharistic Ministers who bring Holy Communion. To arrange a pastoral visit, please contact the Parish Office.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

This sacrament is received by those suffering from a potentially life-threatening illness, those planning to have serious surgery, and those in advanced years. Please do not wait until the 'last minute' to request the sacrament; contact the Parish Office.

Alpha

"Alpha" is a time to connect in a small group with others who are open to exploring life, faith, and meaning. Weekly sessions include sharing a meal, a brief video on an element of the Christian faith, and an opportunity for sharing individual thoughts and questions. 
